WHEREAS, The Contractor has the necessary expertise in one of these areas and ability to provide such lecture or presentation.

THEREFORE, it is mutually agreed between the parties as follows:

1. The Contractor shall make a presentation on _____ .
2. The lecture/presentation shall be on _____ unless other dates or times shall be mutually agreed upon between The Contractor and the President of MLA.
3. Upon completion of said presentation, MLA shall pay the Contractor the sum of _____ .
4. Travel expenses will be paid at current rates set by MLA, if applicable.
5. It is expressly understood that The Contractor is an independent contractor and not an employee of MLA.
6. MLA reserves the right to cancel the lecture/conference for any reason. In this event, the Contractor will be notified at least five (5) business days prior to the scheduled presentation date. MLA will pay up to \$200 in transportation fees if travel plans need to be altered and a penalty incurred due to the charge.
7. If the lecture/conference is canceled within five (5) business days of the scheduled time due to weather or other unforeseen circumstance, MLA will make its best effort to reschedule the event.

AGREEMENT TO ELECTRONICALLY PUBLISH PRESENTATION MATERIALS

The Contractor gives MLA permission to publish any slides, notes, handouts or other similar material from the presentation to which the Contractor owns publishing rights on the MLA website. The Contractor retains copyright to all such material.
